



Below are quick instructions on how to turn off Universal Tools for a student.




- Turning OFF Universal Tools is not part of the student’s accommodations information, but any addition or change of an accommodation does need to be added in TIDE.
- NOTE: This can also be used for changing a student’s settings, but we caution that changes made in these screens are by test only and any additions of accommodations will need to be added into the student’s record TIDE

1. Once the session has begun and the student has signed in, the Test Administrator can open the students awaiting approval box and click on the “eye” icon next to the student.




The screenshot shows the 'Approvals and Student Test Settings' modal window. At the top, it says '1 students awaiting approval'. Below is a table with the following data:
